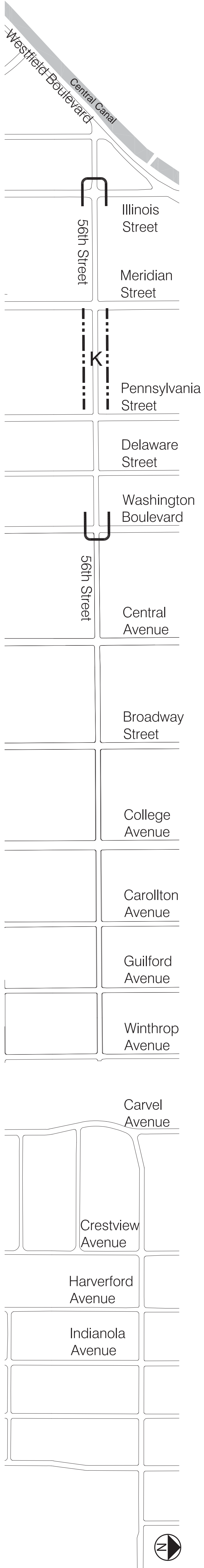

56TH STREET



56th Street

56th Street, except for its lack of sidewalks between Illinois Street and Washington Boulevard, and the lack of full intersection control at Central Avenue, would be a good candidate for the current Safe-Route-to School development program.

Additionally, with its Meridian Street traffic signal and crosswalk, this sidewalk bereft section falls well within an easy five minute walk to the Illinois Street district of convenience shopping and restaurants, and within half mile or 10 minute walk of the riviera Club, a neighborhood destination.

Thus this vision plan element, and near term project to fill this sidewalk gap and to add full intersection control (all-way stop and crosswalks) at Washington Boulevard will make a great contribution to neighborhood connectivity and walkability.

The proposal, now funded for near-term implementation, will place a new sidewalk on the south side of 56th between Illinois Street and Washington Boulevard, and an all-way stop at Central Avenue.
